Role Description

The Sanitation Team Lead sort outs sanitation for Underland. You'll need to ensure every participant has access to safe, reliable and environmentally friendly toilets. To do this, you'll have a crew to help you on the paddock and the full support of the Site crew. You'll negotiate contracts with local suppliers of toilets, water and sewage, and ensure we have the right people on crew and manage the system during the event.

Ideal skills and attributes

- Ability to delegate effectively
- Experience in conflict resolution
- Excellent communication skills, including managing email
- Good understanding of small team dynamics
- Desire to encourage good relationships within the team and with contractors
- High standards in personal hygiene
- Excellent cleaning and sanitation practices
- Interest in sustainable environmental practices
- Willing to work to meet the need

Amenities provided

- Hot showers
- 3 prepared meals/day during build and packdown
- 1 prepared meal/day + self-serve snacks and food during event

Time commitment

- Year-round: 1-2 hours/week
- Onsite: Two days pre-event and one day post- event
- Shift Length: 2-3 hrs when onsite
